

# Embark on an Unforgetable Franco-Swiss Adventure

Located between Lake Geneva and Mont Blanc, the Portes du Soleil is a cross-border ski area, with 12 resorts connected between France and Switzerland: Abondance, Avoriaz, Champéry, Châtel, La Chapelle d'Abondance, Les Gets, Montriond, Morzine, Morgins, Saint Jean d'Aulps, Torgon and Val-d'Illiez -Les Crosets - Champoussin. Some resorts are villages with a traditional alpine style, others such as Avoriaz are purposed-built with a unique architecture.

Opening dates: 20 December 2025 to 12 April 2026



The closest airport is Geneva and there are transfers to all the resorts.

Visitors can also come by train to Cluses or Thonon in France and get

a bus or taxi to the chosen resort.

# **New for** winter 2025-26

## A new mountain hut

### BETWEEN MORZINE AND CHAMPÉRY () ©

At 1,920 meters, the Cabane du Col de Cou is a former customs house that has been transformed into a guarded refuge accommodating up to 40 guests. Scheduled to open in autumn 2025, the Cabane du Col de Cou will welcome guests all year-round, offering an exceptional experience right on the French-Swiss border. Accessible from Morzine (7 km with 500 meters of elevation gain) or via the GR5, the

Via Alpina, and Tour des Dents Blanches, it is one of the few mountain refuges open during winter, reachable by snowshoe or ski. Guests are treated to breathtaking views of the majestic Dents du Midi and the Swiss slopes of the Portes du Soleil. Committed to have as less impact as possible on the environment, the refuge prioritizes sustainable energy and responsible waste management practices.

# **New lifts**

### LA ROSTA CHAIRLIFT - LES GETS ()

In December 2025, the old 4-seater chairlift at Les Gets will be replaced by a new, modern 8-seater chairlift. This new lift will be faster, operating at a speed of 6 meters per second, and will provide greater comfort for skiers. It is equipped with a Direct Drive motor, which helps lower noise levels, reduces energy usage, and minimizes environmental impact.

# THE LINGA CHAIRLIFT - CHÂTEL ()

The Linga gondola will be replaced by a new, high-speed 6-seater chairlift. This upgrade will significantly reduce travel time to just 5 minutes, thanks to the lift's speed of 6 meters per second. The chairlift will also increase capacity, transporting up to 3,000 people per hour, compared to the previous 2,230. Built with fewer pylons (13 instead of 21) and featuring a quiet, hydrocarbonfree, eco-friendly motor, the new lift is designed to minimize its environmental impact.

A new building at the top of the lift will include a picnic room with panoramic views of Châtel and the valley.

On the slopes of Morgins, at 1,700m, facing the majestic Dents du Midi, the Gîte Alpage La Chaux is a traditional chalet that dates back to 1871. It serves delicious homecooked meals crafted from fresh, local, and seasonal ingredients. This winter, the Gîte Alpage La Chaux is opening two cozy bedrooms on the upper floor, offering peaceful accommodations for up to seven guests.

### CHAMPÉRY O

A popular gathering spot since the late 18th century, Le Centre is stepping into a new era. Listed as a local heritage site, Le Centre has been thoughtfully restored, blending its rich historical character with striking contemporary design. Le Centre encompasses several areas: a gourmet restaurant open for lunch and dinner, a friendly café-bar, luxury apartments, and a contemporary wine cellar for events. Having officially reopened in mid-August, Le Centre is now preparing to welcome guests for its very first winter season.


Rock the Pistes is the pioneer of high-altitude festivals. Every winter for almost a decade, the Rock the Pistes festival has delighted music and ski fans.
